
WHY IS SURVEY STANDARDIZATION IMPORTANT?

- Comparability across time and region
- Data quality and reliability
- Cost efficiency and reusability
- Policy and planning support



CROSS-GOVERNMENTAL COLLABORATION

- Consistency across jurisdictions
- Efficient use of resources
- Informed funding and investment decisions
- Better infrastructure and policy planning



CENSUS TRANSPORTATION PLANNING PRODUCTS (CTPP)

- Derived from the U.S. Census Bureau's American Community Survey (ACS)
 - ACS accumulates data over multiple months and years
 - Annual Data
 - Supplemental Estimates
 - 5 Years of Data
- Provides information on
 - Residences
 - Workplaces
 - Journey-to-Work Flows

STANDARDIZATION WITHIN ACS

- Changes over time
 - Example: Means of Transportation to Work
